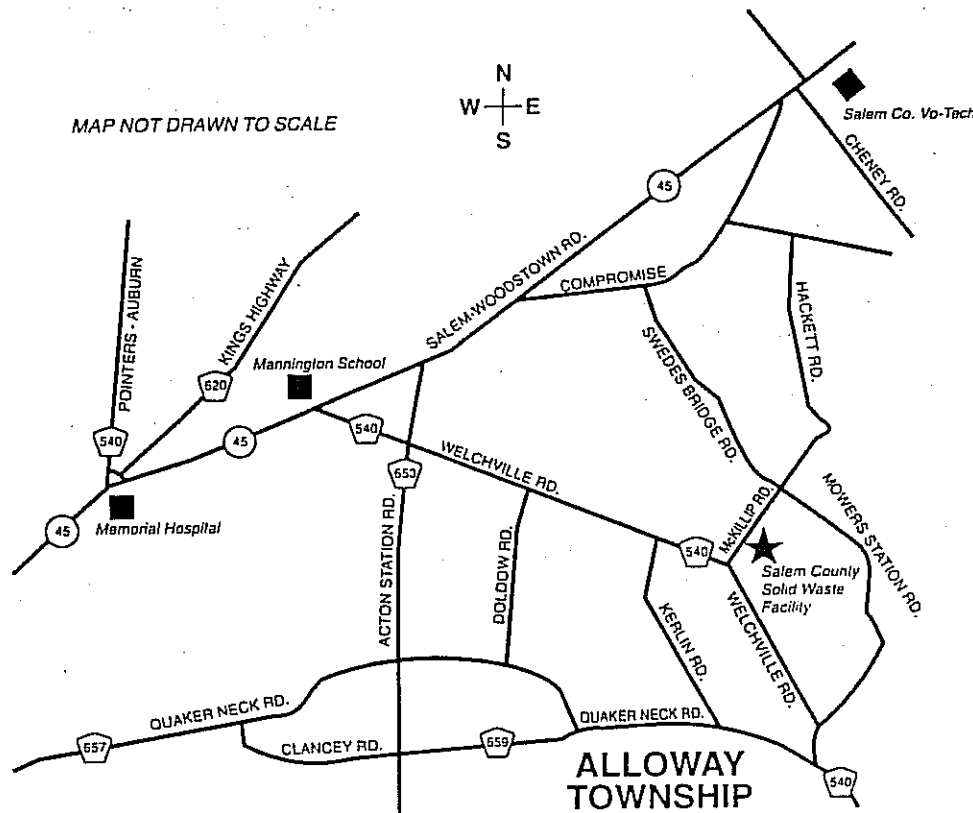
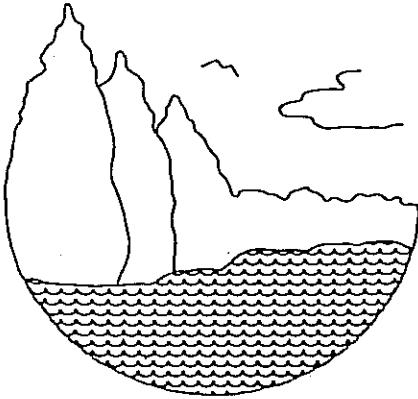

- gasoline & antifreeze
- used oil filters
- kerosene
- motor oil
(if your town has no collection location)
- used cooking oil
- fluorescent bulbs

WE WILL NOT ACCEPT

- unidentified waste
- explosives or water reactives
- shock sensitive chemicals
- radioactive / infectious waste
- latex - water based paint
- 2,4,5 - TP silvex
- * excess quantities

All materials must be identifiable and/or in original container

* Maximum quantity limited to:

200 pounds of dry material not to exceed 100 pounds per container
and/or 20 gallons of liquid not to exceed 5 gallons per container
for each participant.
